Electrical Systems: Largest new electrical installation in Southern California

incorporating new 30,000 sq.ft electrical vault, 50,000 amps of 480 volt power, dozens of bus duct installation and new

power risers

Emergency Systems: Entire electrical system including 15 -1500 KW generators,

50,000 gallons of emergency water, 80,000 gallons of emergency

fuel, miles of piping and remote generator radiator farm

Mechanical Systems: New 3000 ton central HVAC system with N+1 redundancy

Common Areas: Complete renovation of all common areas including new

elevators, security systems, exterior, roof and HVAC system
